A motion was made by Kroneck and supported by King to approve the agenda as submitted. 6 Yes. 0 No. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Kroneck and supported by Petersen to approve the Minutes to the Public Hearing to amend ordinance # 205, 206, and 207 and to create Ordinance # 208 as submitted. 6 Yes. 0 No. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Kroneck and supported by Petersen to hold a Public Hearing on June 23, 2015 at 7:00 pm to amend the sidewalk ordinance. 6 Yes. No. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Petersen and supported by Yoder to hold a Public Hearing on June 23, 2015 at 7:00 pm to amend to water use Ordinance. 6 Yes. 0 No. Motion carried.

Citizen Comments: Ray Holloway suggested having different levels on charges. Naomi Holloway question if anyone could fill a pool for \$100 if they changed the ordinance. Ron Blum asked about the enforcement of the blighted house ordinance.
