August 12, 2015

The meeting was called to order at 7:05 pm by Mayor Tissue-Daws.

Commissioners present: Yoder, Burris, Petersen, Johnson, Kroneck and Corwin. Absent: None.

A motion was made by Petersen and supported by Burris to approve the agenda with the addition that Kroneck wanted to make an announcement. 6 Yes. 0 No. Motion carried.

Citizens Comments: Joel Black, Jill Black, Jackie Black and Jerry Black spoke to the Commission regarding their property between Second St. and W First St.

Ray Holloway asked about the video taping of the Commission meetings.

A motion was made by Kroneck and supported by Corwin to approve the minutes to the July 28, 2015 meeting as submitted.

DPW Report was read.

Police Report was read and Chief Patino added that they are preparing for the weekend festival.

City Managers report: City manager Eckholm informed the Commission that Clock will be installed the first of September. New Employee in DPW and Office. DPW flushed Hydrants. Sidewalks project has been started. Received contracts from MCRC for repairs of streets. He also informed the Commission that he would be absent from the next meeting.

A motion was made and supported to add another item to the agenda: Bids from Road Commission for repair streets. 6 Yes. 0 No. Motion carried

A motion was made by Yoder and supported Kroneck to have separate ordinances to repeal the ordinances discussed in public hearing. Burris, Yoder and Corwin voted Yes. Petersen, Johnson, and Kroneck voted No. Mayor Tissue-Daws voted "no" to break the tie vote.

A motion was made by Yoder and supported by Kroneck to take roll call vote on each individual ordinance. 6 Yes. 0 No. Motion carried.

Ordinance to repeal the above Ordinances adopted.

A motion was made by Yoder and supported by Petersen to approve the temporary permit to use City Water for the OFD Committee for August 11-16 accessing hydrants at W. Day and Camburn, N. Camburn and Alley, S. Camburn and Main, Lincoln and Main and DPW building. 6 Yes. 0 No. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Kroneck and supported by Petersen to approve the contracts with Montcalm County Road Commission to repair streets in the City choosing the option to paving the whole block of Day St between State St and W First St. 6 Yes. 0 No. Motion carried.

Commission/Mayor Pro-Tem John Kroneck submitted his resignation to the City Commission stating he would be moving out of the City and would no long be able to serve on the Commission.

Yoder received a card of appreciation from the neighborhood citizens for the "Child at Play Signs" installed.

A motion was made and supported to adjourn the meeting. Meeting adjourned at approximately 7:40 pm.
